



HOW TO GET YOUR FORM I-20

Certificate of Eligibility for F-1 Students

WHAT IS A FORM I-20 AND WHY DO I NEED ONE?

A Form I-20 is a government form on which we certify to the U.S. Government that you are eligible to apply for an F-1 student visa.

We certify that you have met our admission requirements, have been accepted for a full course of study, and have proven to us that you have enough money to study and live in the U.S. without working illegally or suffering from poverty.

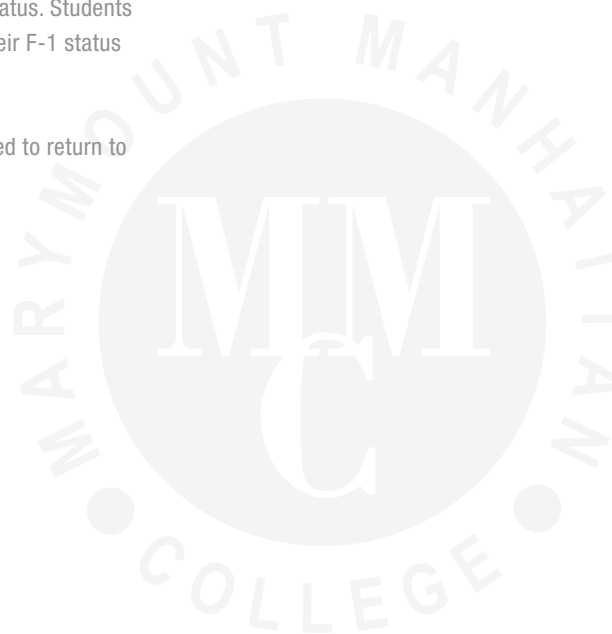
You need a Form I-20 to obtain an F-1 student visa or to maintain F-1 status when transferring or changing schools within the U.S. Transferring students do not have to receive our I-20 before coming to Marymount Manhattan College unless they are traveling outside the U.S. before classes begin.

DOES EVERYBODY NEED A FORM I-20?

If you are in possession of another visa that allows you to study, you do not have to have an I-20 and may attend school full or part-time as per immigration regulations. Dependent children in E, F, H, I, J, L, M, N, O, P, R or S status need to change status before their 21st birthday or if they get married. If you have no legal status, you may attend school but you are not eligible to change status and do not need an I-20.

Please be advised that a non-immigrant B-1 or B-2 visitor who entered the U.S. on or after April 12, 2002, is PROHIBITED by U.S. law from pursuing "a course of study" before obtaining a change to an F-1 status. Students on B1/B2 visas must obtain their F-1 visas through their home country U.S. consulates or have their F-1 status approved by USCIS before they can start classes.

If you enter the U.S. on a "visa waiver", you will be permitted to stay for only 90 days. You will need to return to your home country and apply for an F-1 visa.
